

STUDY PROGRAMMES TAUGHT IN DUTCH BUT OPEN TO INTERNA-TIONAL STUDENTS

Most of the master's degree programmes taught in Dutch as well as the bachelor's degree programme in Music are also open to English-speaking students, even though the official teaching language of these programmes remains Dutch.

TUITION FEES

Degree students from EEA countries pay the same tuition fee as Flemish students. When enrolled for a 60 ECTS study programme a student from an EEA country pays a tuition fee of +/- € 1.600. In many cases students from non-EEA countries pay the same amount. Only in some cases, like in the Music programme or Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Courses students from non-EEA countries pay an amount that is considerably higher than the fee for EEA students.
